- Possession of, or ability to obtain, a valid class C California driver's license is required.

Fire Inspector II

- In addition to the education requirements for Fire Inspector I, college level course work in fire prevention and building trades is highly desirable.
- Two (2) years of fire inspection and prevention experience equivalent to that of a Fire Inspector I within the City of Fairfield is required.
- In addition to the license and/or certificate requirements for Fire Inspector I, possession of or ability to obtain, a California State Fire Inspector I or Public Education Officer I Certification is required.
