


Homeless Services Manager

EXPERIENCE & QUALIFICATIONS

- Five (5) years progressively responsible experience working in local government or a non-profit environment with diverse agencies in the provision of services to homeless or at-risk populations, including two (2) years experience in a lead or supervisory capacity.
- A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in Social Work, Behavioral Science, Business Administration, or Public Administration or a closely related field. A Master's degree is highly desirable.
