## **CURRENT PROJECTS/FOCUS**

The City of Fairfield is in the midst of an evolutionary time in its history. At the heart of that evolution is the Planning Division, which is currently working to plan and or implement the following projects:

- A General Plan update that includes the City's first Climate Action Plan, an increased focus on mixed-use and multifamily housing development, and transforming transportation the network to accommodate improved bike and pedestrian connectivity to transit.
- Implementation of the Train Station Specific Plan that focuses on high-quality development surrounding a new Capitol Corridor/Amtrak commuter train station. The Specific Plan includes planned use development areas that will see the development of thousands of new housing units within walking distance of the station.
- Implementation of the Heart of Fairfield Specific Plan that focuses on urbanization and revitalization of the historic downtown and surrounding neighborhoods. The plan envisions the transformation of central Fairfield to a transit rich and high-density mixed-use corridor, with primary economic development focus on creating a Food and Arts District.

## THE POSITIONS

The Planning Division is currently accepting applications to fill two Planner positions. Based on the successful candidates' qualifications and experience, the positions may be filled at either the Principal or Senior level.

#### PRINCIPAL PLANNER

This classification oversees entitlement functions and professional and technical staff. The Principal Planner manages complex projects, serve as the City Zoning Administrator, hires consultants, provides recommendations to leadership, and reviews and prepares CEQA and NEPA reports.

#### SENIOR PLANNER

This classification performs wide variety of current and long range planning assignments, with emphasis on review and processing of high priority and complex current planning applications. The Senior Planner will be integral in contributing to the City's General Plan update and will review and update cannabis permits.





## **QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE**

#### PRINCIPAL PLANNER

- Five (5) years of professional experience in urban planning including one year management experience involving planning activities is required.
- A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major work in planning, landscape architecture, or public administration is required. Master's Degree in planning or related field is desired.

#### SENIOR PLANNER

- Five (5) years of increasingly responsible professional planning experience is required.
- A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major work in urban planning or related field is required. A Master's degree in planning or related field is desirable.

Possession of a valid Class C California Driver's License is required.
