ABOUT THE COMMUNITY

Snoqualmie is located about 30 miles east of Seattle. It is home to a population of approximately 14,000. The community is graced by Snoqualmie Falls, which is located near the Salish Lodge and Spa that attracts nearly 2.2 million visitors each year. The city hosts a historic train depot, managed and operated by the Puget Sound Railway Historic Association.

ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION

The city operates under a Mayor/ Council form of government, with the City Administrator serving as the Chief Operating Officer. The city provides police services to the neighboring city of North Bend through an interlocal agreement (contract). The Snoqualmie Police Chief and Command Staff serve as the designated head of law enforcement for both cities.



ABOUT THE POSITION

This is an at-will Management Professional position under the direction and supervision of the Police Chief. This position:

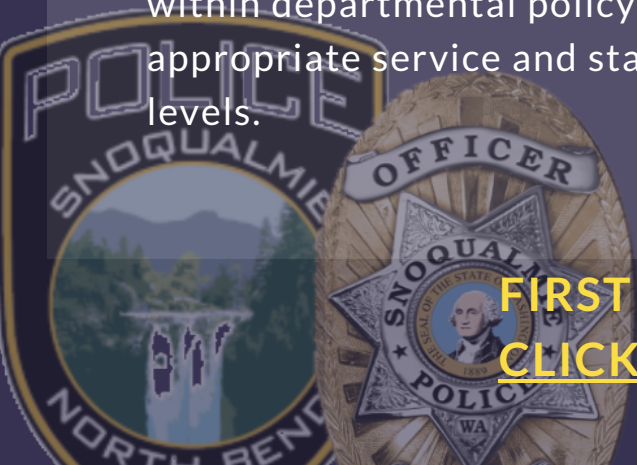
- Plans, organizes, coordinates and manages the day-to-day operations of Sergeants and Patrol Officers, requiring extensive skill and experience in communication, management, and judgment and law enforcement.
- Assists in training of all employees. As necessary, performs any of the duties of Sergeants and Police Officers.
- Acts on behalf of the Police Chief during his/her absence.
- Assures that operations and standards are maintained and are consistent with departmental goals and objectives.
- Monitors and evaluates the efficiency and effectiveness of service delivery methods and procedures and recommend within departmental policy appropriate service and staffing levels.
